NOTES:

1. Branches will decide when certification will be required and when training will be adequate.
2. Old NCCP workshops may be offered until 2009 in locations where new LF's have not yet been trained.
3. Certification will be required for Sport Coaches before they can move to Club Coach. This can be achieved through a challenge by evaluation.

If you have completed sections of the old NCCP and wish to continue with coaching education, review the scenarios below to determine your next step:

SCENARIO 1: Completed Level 1 Theory, Level 1 Technical, but no Practical components and wish to be certified at Level 1: Contact your provincial branch regarding the requirements for completion of Level 1 Practical or contact Donna Kaye (dkaye@athletics.ca) for information regarding evaluation in the Sport Coach context.

SCENARIO 2: Completed Sport Coach and Introduction to Competition A and wish to be certified at Level 1 (Sport Coach): Contact Donna Kaye (dkaye@athletics.ca) for information regarding an evaluation in the Sport Coach context.

SCENARIO 3: Completed Level 1 Technical and Level 2 Technical, but no Theory and no Practical components and wish to be certified at Level 1 and 2: You will need to contact your provincial coaching body and enrol in Introduction to Competition A and Introduction to Competition B. You have the option to either contact your provincial branch regarding the practical requirements for Level 1 and 2 OR contact Donna Kaye (dkaye@athletics.ca) for information regarding an evaluation in the Sport Coach and Club Coach context.

SCENARIO 4: Certified at Level 1, completed Club Coach and wish to be certified at Level 2 (Club Coach): Contact Donna Kaye (dkaye@athletics.ca) for information regarding an evaluation in the Club Coach context.

SCENARIO 5: Completed Level 1, 2, and 3 Technical, Level 1 Theory and no Practical components and wish to be certified: Contact your provincial coaching body and enrol in Introduction to Competition B, followed by Level 3 Theory. Contact your provincial branch regarding the requirements for completion of the relevant practical components.
