

As some of you may know, I recently agreed to Chair the Saskatchewan Officials Committee (SOC). A big “Thank-you” to Jim Langen for the work he has done over the past number of years as Committee Chair.

We will be looking for officials across the province to be involved in the Committee and work together for the needs of all officials. Please contact me by phone, 384-5579 or email, margaret.hucul@sasktel.net if you are interested in any of the following positions:

- Mentoring and Clinic Coordinators (one person from North, one from South) – preferably a Level 5 Official with key responsibilities of organizing mentors and clinics for Level 3, 4 & 5 officials;
- Associate Mentoring and Clinic Coordinators (one person from North and one from South) - preferably a Level 3 Official with key responsibilities of organizing mentors and clinics for Level 1 & 2 officials;
- Upgrading Coordinator – senior Official familiar with all the requirements for all Levels in all disciplines. Reviews and recommends to the Committee all upgrading of officials;
- Meet Officials Consultant – liaise with the individual Meet Official Coordinators to exchange information and design aids for simplifying the process and reduce the time for gathering adequate officials for sanctioned meets. Provide input on behalf of Committee at Meet Directors meetings;
- Discipline Coordinator – liaise with key



contacts in each of the six major disciplines of the sport (Starts, Umpires, Photo finish, Throws, Vertical Jumps and Horizontal Jumps).

- Secretary/Recorder – meeting minutes and communication. Minutes to be circulated to committee members and Saskatchewan Athletics Office.

I have some minutes from an April 2010 SOC meeting that show some of these positions being filled. In the next few weeks I will be contacting those named in the minutes to see if they are interested in continuing in the role they held at the time of the April 2010 meeting.

I am looking forward to another exciting season of officiating and working together to develop our committee. The committee works to coordinate the recruitment, training and upgrading of track and field officials who are members of Saskatchewan Athletics.
