

2022 Sanderson Classic Track Meet Cancelled

SASKATOON – Huskie Athletics announced Thursday the cancellation of the January 14 & 15 2022 Sanderson Classic indoor track and field event. This decision was made to ensure the health and safety of the athletes, coaches, staff, officials, and volunteers due to a current marked increase of COVID-19 cases in Saskatchewan, fueled by the spread of the Omicron variant.

The Huskies Track & Field teams were set to host the event at the Saskatoon Field House, competing against five university track teams from across Canada West.

“Our student-athletes have been training exceptionally hard over the past several months in anticipation of this year’s Sanderson Classic. However, we recognize that it is in the best interest of the health and safety of everyone involved and the Saskatoon community to cancel the 2022 Classic,” said Huskie Track and Field coach Jason Reindl. “Unfortunately, the Sanderson Classic is not able to be rescheduled, so we now look forward to competing at the Canada West championships later this term.”

The Sanderson Classic is an open event which also had registration open to any member of a Track & Field club, and elementary school relay races. More than 600 athletes had been expected to compete. All Sanderson Classic events have been cancelled for 2022.

The Canada West Track and Field Championships are slated to take place on February 25 & 26 at the University of Manitoba.
